The facility also reports tolerance specifications of less than 1% active pharmaceutical ingredient (API) variability across its initial production batches. While the Florida DOH Office of Medical Marijuana Use has not specified variability requirements, the Columbia Care manufacturing facility's ability to achieve less than 1% API variability is well below the U.S. Food and Drug Administration's 10% benchmark for API variability for pharmaceutical products sold in the U.S.

"Receiving GMP certification in Florida is a significant milestone for Columbia Care and demonstrates our unwavering national commitment to delivering the highest-quality cannabis-based medicines to our patients, not only throughout Florida but across the country," said Nicholas Vita, chief executive officer of Columbia Care.
